The following is in response to Ms. Hernandez's request for a course-by-course evaluation of her academic credentials from Cuba. This evaluation was prepared based on official original academic credentials.

Ms. Hernandez attended the "Marta Abreu" Central University of Las Villas (*Universidad Central "Marta Abreu" de Las Villas*) from 2017 to 2020. Founded in 1952, the "Marta Abreu" Central University of Las Villas is a public institution of higher education accredited by the Ministry of Higher Education in Cuba. In order to be admitted into the "Marta Abreu" Central University of Las Villas, applicants must have the High School diploma (*Bachiller*). This is the equivalent of graduation from a college preparatory program at an accredited high school in the United States.

Ms. Hernandez was enrolled in the undergraduate program in Information Technology Engineering (*Ingenieria Informatica*), but she left the "Marta Abreu" Central University of Las Villas without graduating in 2020. This is the equivalent of completion of 87.25 semester credit hours of undergraduate study in Information Technology and related courses at a regionally accredited institution of higher education in the United States. Ms. Hernandez did not request the calculation of her grade point average.
